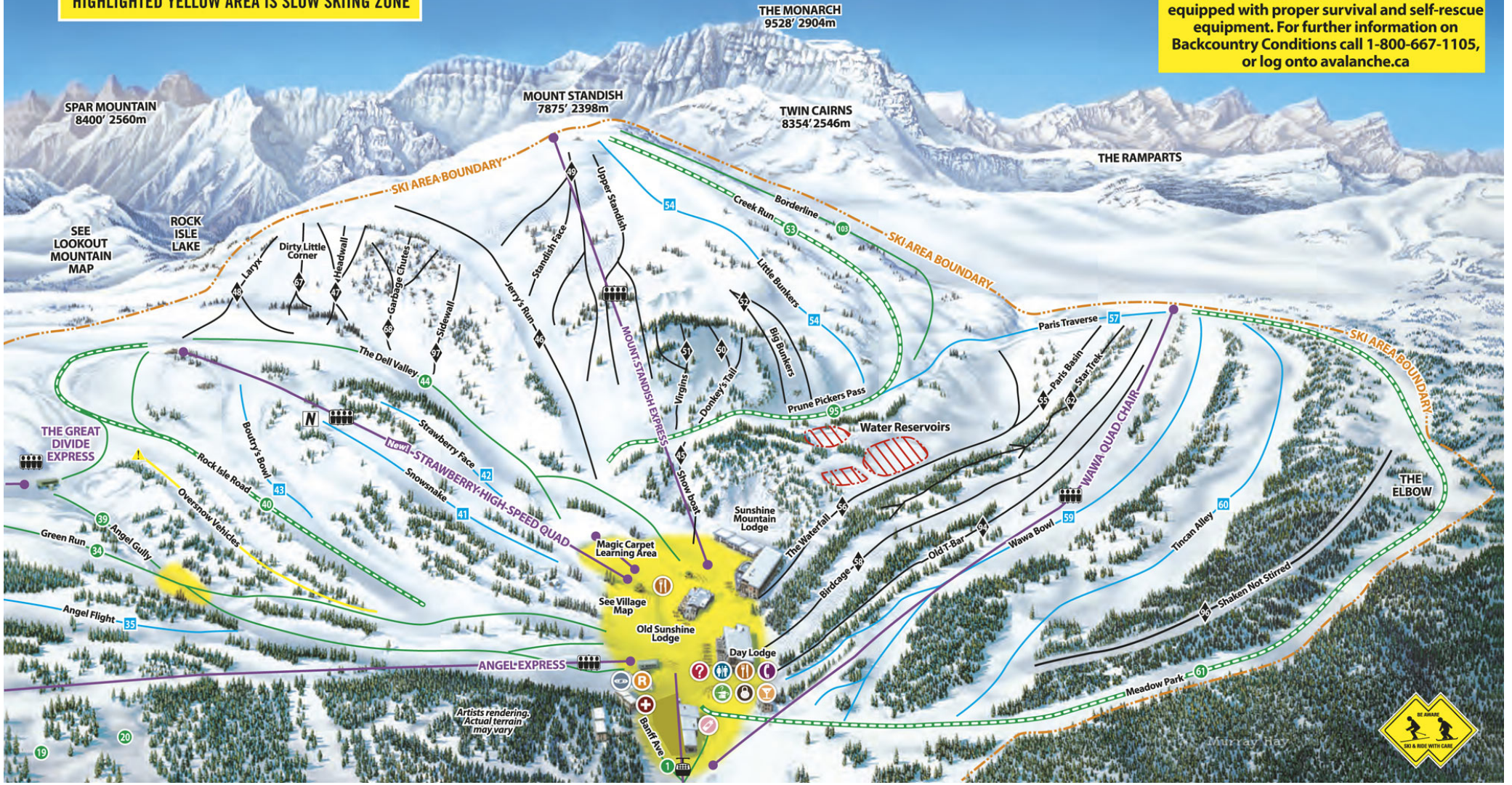


# MOUNT STANDISH

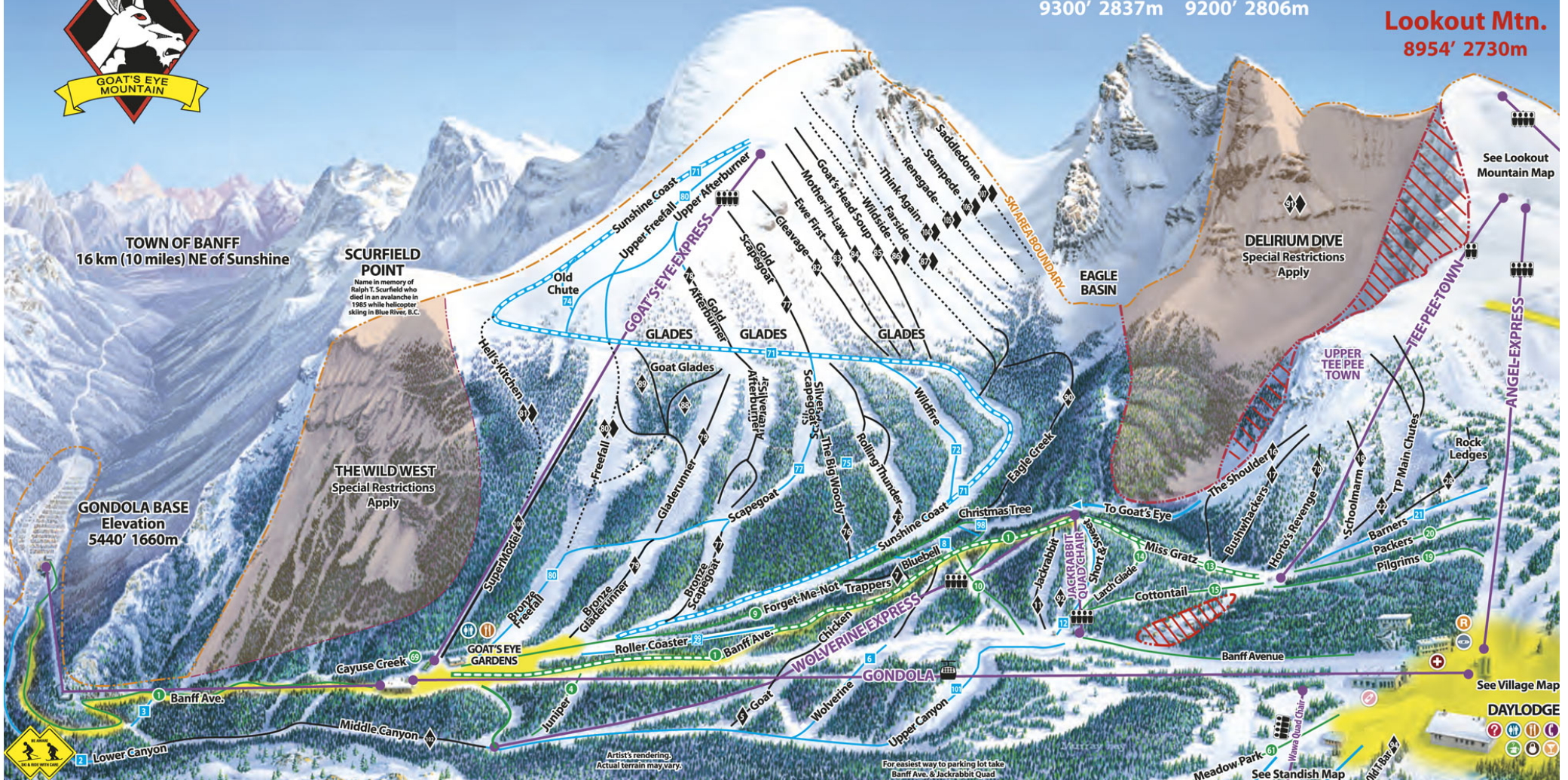
